


FEMA/Emergency Management Institute Independent Study Course Completion Instructions

Kansas **TRAIN**

How to set up a learner account on KansasTRAIN (if you do **not** have an account)


1. Point your browser to <https://www.train.org/ks/>
2. Click on the “Create Account” button in the Login blue box. 
3. Complete the online registration form to set up your account. **Choose a login ID and password that are unique to you**, write this information down and keep it in a safe place. You should receive an email welcoming you to KansasTRAIN.
4. To receive registration notifications chose to receive TRAIN emails from the ‘Notification’ screen located at the top right-hand corner. For more information [GO HERE](#)



To locate and enroll in the basic FEMA/EMI emergency preparedness courses:

5. **IMPORTANT:** Independent Study Exams require a FEMA Student Identification (SID) Number to take the final exam. If you do not have a SID, register for one today: <https://cdp.dhs.gov/femaside>.
6. To complete the Independent Study modules go to <http://www.train.org/ks/> and login to your account.
7. Add the course number to the ‘Search by Keyword or Course ID’ field located on the upper-right hand side of the homepage.



8. Click the course title link to view ‘Course Details’ information; Select the ‘Registration’ tab, and follow the prompts to begin the course.
9. **IMPORTANT:** If you ‘Quit’ an Independent Study course and come back later, go to the **My Learning** link on the right hand side of the KansasTRAIN homepage, select the “In Progress” link to the right hand side of the course title to re-enter the course. 
10. Select the “Begin Training” arrow and the “Lesson” where you left off. If you were ready to take the final exam you may have to click through the final lesson to navigate to the exam.



13. **IMPORTANT:** Print a copy of the certificate and give to the designated personnel for your training file and **forward the course completion auto email to kdhe.kstrain@ks.gov** for verification on your TRAIN Transcript.
14. **Highly Recommended!** Upload your Independent Study certificates to your TRAIN Transcript for safe keeping.
