## **Kansas TRAIN Online Course Navigation Instructions**

Kansas learners access current or "Classic" Kansas TRAIN at https://ks.train.org, all others go to www.train.org.

On **September 28, 2017**, the NEW **Kansas TRAIN 3.0** URL will be: https://www.train.org/ks. The Kansas TRAIN 3.0 platform will be compatible with most browsers and devices.

- 1. Kansas TRAIN online courses may include handouts, audio, video, pre/post assessments, an evaluation and a certificate.
- 2. For "Classic" Kansas TRAIN, use Google Chrome or Internet Explorer as your browser. Turn **OFF** your Pop-Up blockers if you are using Internet Explorer. Click this link for instructions. http://kstrain.kdhe.state.ks.us/trainlive/Brochures/2017/Internet%20Explorer%20Instructions%202017.pdf
- 3. Some courses may require that you have the latest version of Adobe Reader, Flash and/or Java. Click on the images below to update these programs.



4. To exit or **Quit**, any web-based/on-line course posted to Kansas TRAIN, click the **Quit** button located in the banner above the course.

5. To return to the course, login to Kansas TRAIN and access the course through **My Learning** in classic Kansas TRAIN or **Your Learning** in Kansas TRAIN 3.0.

**Note:** When returning to the course there will be a popup box with the following: **You have previously been in this lesson. Would you like to return to the last visited location in the lesson? You must click OK**. This will ensure that the previous information you completed is recorded.

6. After completing the course evaluation, a certificate of completion (if applicable) will be available via the **Certificate** link on the right hand side of the classic Kansas TRAIN home page. All your learning documents on Kansas TRAIN 3.0 can be accessed via **Your Learning** in the navigation bar.

- 7. To receive Kansas TRAIN Registration auto emails you must **Opt IN** to receive KS-TRAIN emails.

## Internet Explorer (IE) – enabling websites to be viewed in "Compatibility Mode"

- 3. Locate & click "Tools" on the top menu.
